# Adventure And Survival Camp

10th - 14th (one week)

10 - 16 Years Old

This is a very practical camp and kids will be constantly engaged in a variety of outdoor activities. They will have the opportunity to make many things themselves, using clay, bamboo, and other natural materials. We will coach kids to safely use machetes, hand axes and other tools and provide supervision so they develop confidence in using these tools. They will also learn many practical skills such as starting a fire and cooking food and will learn how to stay safe within the forest. Kids will learn about wildlife and how to spot it in the forest, they will experience nature and begin to feel comfortable in exploring nature. They will have fun being part of a team, making new friends and working together to overcome challenges.

## Instructors

Our instructors have lived in Thailand for many years. They have coordinated successful adventurous activities programs for some of the largest international schools in Chiang Mai. They are passionate about nature and the outdoors and sharing this passion with others. They have learned about many of the birds and animals that live in the area and have a good knowledge of their secretive world. They have trekked extensively in the mountains and forests of the north and learned from locals of the dangers and how to avoid them. Our instructors are also qualified teachers who are passionate about learning and see outdoor education as an opportunity for children to develop self-confidence, learn how to work effectively with others, and also to develop a positive relationship with nature.
