FAQs for IGCSE for Homeschool

1. Why should homeschool students consider IGCSE at MBIS?

MBIS offers flexibility for homeschool students with a range of subjects. We provide a structured curriculum, assessment, and certification that can enhance students' academic profiles and prepare them for further studies or careers.

2. What will the timetable be like?

The full timetable is scheduled as eight 50-minute periods each day. As an IGCSE for Homeschool student, that will most likely involve you doing Core (English, Maths and Science) subjects and either Block A or Block B subjects. Block A is Business Studies and Computer Science. Block B is Geography and Global Perspectives. 3. How often do I need to go to school?

Core subjects are scheduled five days a week, and depending on the block you select, most days you may finish your subjects by lunchtime.

4. Do I need a uniform?

Yes, for the cohesion of our IGCSE cohorts and as an integral part of our school community, you will need to observe our secondary uniform guidelines.

5. What extra classes/activities can I join?

If you wish to enrol for additional scheduled classes in addition to your chosen block, this can be arranged through our Admissions team for an additional fee. We encourage our IGCSE for Homeschool students to take advantage of our extracurricular activities like sports teams and co-curricular activities like student council and values-based community service.



6. What is the fee structure?

IGCSE for Homeschool students who register and make payment before June 14, 2024 are eligible for a 60% discount on regular tuition fee. Also, the new student enrolment fee is waived.

7. What subjects are available in the IGCSE curriculum at MBIS?

We currently offer 7 IGCSE subjects. You can read the details here:

Yes. After your first year of study, you can apply for our Academic Scholarship Programme in the second and subsequent years

10. Can a homeschool student become a full-time student if interested?

Yes. We have a conversion enrollment window between each term.
